## **East Granby Farms Recreation Building Facility Use Guidelines**



- No alcohol or intoxicating substances are allowed on the premises.
- Smoking and vaping are prohibited on the premises.
- Candles and open flames are not permitted.
- Decorations may not be attached to walls or acoustic panels. They may only be taped to wood, metal, or plastic surfaces, and all tape must be fully removed after the event. The use of tacks and staples is prohibited.
- Youth groups must be properly supervised in proportion to their size.
- Religious services may be not be conducted on the premises.
- The Recreation Center may not be used for personal financial gain.
- All trash must be bagged and disposed of in the dumpster located outside the building.
- The room must be returned to its original setup.
- Tables must be wiped down, and the kitchen must be thoroughly cleaned if used. The floor must be swept clean. Please note: Cleaning supplies, dish soap, sponges, paper towels, etc. are <u>not</u> provided by the town.
- No food should be left in the refrigerator, freezer, oven or microwave.
- Please turn off all lights and lock the building when leaving.
