Welcome to the 2024 East Granby Festive Holiday Trail!

Thank you to everyone who decorated their homes and joined in spreading holiday cheer by registering their address!

Feel free to enjoy the festive decorations in any order you prefer, but this route is designed to help you cover all the beautiful displays efficiently. Turn on some holiday tunes and enjoy the journey!

<u>Start</u> at the Town Complex on Center Street and head over to School Street toward School House Landing. Take a RIGHT into School House Landing and head around the circle. Look for:

★ 67 School House Landing (There is sure to be more along the way!)

After you've completed the School House Landing loop, take a LEFT back out onto School Street and then take a RIGHT and head to the traffic light. Cross through the Rte. 20 intersection and head toward...

★ 80 North Main Street (On the right-hand side across from EG Farms)

Continue driving on North Main Street. Keep your eyes out for...

★ 138 North Main Street

AND

★ 140 North Main Street

Take a LEFT on Ridge Boulevard and do a U-turn to head back down North Main Street. Then, take a RIGHT onto Seneca Drive, followed by a LEFT onto Broken Arrow and a LEFT onto Maize Lane. Be sure to check out:

★ 4 Maize Lane

Continue following Maize Lane until the end; turn RIGHT back onto Seneca Drive, then RIGHT onto North Main Street. When you reach the traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Rte. 20. Turn LEFT onto Hillcrest Road (first left after the USPS light), then RIGHT onto Bayberry Drive. Check out:

★ 12 Bayberry Drive

★ 14 Bayberry Drive

Turn around at the end of Bayberry Drive, and head back towards Hillcrest. Turn LEFT onto Hillcrest then LEFT back onto Rte. 20. *Please watch for traffic and use EXTRA CAUTION when taking a left back onto Rte. 20.*

When you reach the next light, turn RIGHT onto Newgate Road. Follow Newgate all the way to end to the stop sign and proceed straight. Turn RIGHT onto Wyncairne Drive and see the display at:

★ 15 Wyncairne Drive

Turn around at the end of Wyncairne and proceed back towards Newgate Road and take a LEFT onto Newgate. Even though there are no other addresses registered for our light trail, you surely won't be disappointed by the lack of festivity on your way back up Newgate to Rte. 20.

When you reach the traffic light on Rte. 20, turn RIGHT. Pass Turkey Hills Apartments and turn LEFT onto Granger Circle. (If you reach the bike trail, you've gone too far).

This next house is a real treat! You'll want to <u>turn your radio to FM 92.1</u> as you approach the Kardos Family Christmas Light Show at:

★ 12 Granger Circle

Plan to stop and listen and enjoy the lights synced to music!

When you are ready, head back out to Route 20 and take a RIGHT back toward the center of town.

When you get to the light at Newgate/Holcomb, turn RIGHT onto Holcomb Street. Enjoy the lights along the way. When you pass the pass the first entrance to Washington Ridge, be sure to look up to the right and enjoy the view! Then turn RIGHT onto Washington Ridge. You'll be able to see the glow as you approach...

★ 6 Washington Ridge Road

Continue around the horseshoe and enjoy the decorations and lights along the way. When you reach Holcomb again, turn RIGHT. Continue to Hartford Avenue and turn LEFT at the light. Take your second LEFT onto Hatchet Hill Road.

We do not have any addresses registered on Hatchet Hill, but there are surely lots of lights to see along the way, so enjoy the journey!

When you get to the end, continue straight across the Rte. 187 intersection and then turn RIGHT onto Spoonville Road.

Take a right onto Huckleberry Drive, and at the end of the road, take a LEFT onto Heather Lane, then a LEFT onto Cricket Lane. Check out:

★ 1 Cricket Lane

After you enjoy Cricket Lane, take a right on Old County Road, and a quick LEFT onto Brownstone Road. When you reach Spoonville Road, turn RIGHT.

Turn LEFT on Miller Road and then turn RIGHT onto Stark Drive. Check out...

★ 10 Stark Drive

Stark Drive is a horseshoe, so follow the road all the way back to Miller and turn LEFT, then another LEFT back onto Spoonville Road.

Once on Spoonville you will take a LEFT down Tunxis Road toward the river. Be sure to admire the display on the left-hand corner as you turn!

Continue following the road along the river and take a RIGHT into Wynding Hills. At the fork, take a RIGHT and head up the hill. Check out:

★ 26 Wynding Hills

Wynding Hills is a big loop, so just continue around the circle until you are back at the beginning. Take a LEFT back onto Tunxis Avenue and follow the road back to Spoonville. Take a LEFT onto Spoonville Road and a RIGHT onto Rte. 187 to head back to the center of town.
